1. Instruction to Bidders

1.1 Scope of Work

The Rural Municipality of Wallace-Woodworth invites proposals for the 2023 Gravel Supply and Crushing. The following amount of crushed gravel is required within 10 miles at a pit located within the following areas:

- a. 17,000 Cubic Yards – Townships 10, 11 & 12, Range 23 to 25 – (Ward 1)
- b. 10,000 Cubic Yards – Townships 10, 11 & 12, Range 28 & 29 – (Ward 2 West)
- c. 20,000 Cubic Yards – SW Section 36, Township 12, Range 26 – (Ward 2 East) – R.M. Valley Pit (Crush Only)
- d. 10,000 Cubic Yards of A-Base – SW Section 36, Township 12, Range 26 – (Ward 2 East) – R.M. Valley Pit (Crush Only)

NOTE: These are minimum quantities. The Municipality reserves the right to increase the volume as needed.

Commencement of work:

- a. Gravel is to be crushed during the winter/spring months of 2023 for:
 - Townships 10, 11 & 12, Range 23 to 25 – (Ward 1)
 - Townships 10, 11 & 12, Range 28 & 29 – (Ward 2 West)

Stockpiles must be piled with a conveyer type system. The supply is to be available by **June 1, 2023.**

- b. Gravel is to be crushed during late August/early September months of 2023 for:
 - SW Section 36, Township 12, Range 26 – (Ward 2 East) – R.M. Valley Pit

Stockpiles must be piled with a conveyer type system. The supply is to be available by **October 1, 2023.**

1.4 Submission Deadline

Tenders must be received by the Municipality on or before:

Friday, March 31, 2023 at 12:00 p.m.

All submissions must be received no later than the time stipulated in the RFP. Proposals received after the date and time specified will not be considered. RFP submission should include the filled-out Bid Form and all RFP pages with Contractor’s initial.

1.5 Price Submission

The Contractor shall submit unit costs plus the applicable taxes and fees as specified in the Bid Form. Costs will be **inclusive** of:

- Price per yard of crushed gravel
 - a. **Traffic Gravel: *Class A and Class C** (*provide separate pricing for each class*)
NOTE: *The Municipality reserves the right to choose which type of Traffic Gravel price to accept (Class A or Class C) based on budgetary considerations.
 - b. A-Base: Class A
- Necessary stripping (labour/equipment) work on pits
- Prep and cleaning of base site of stockpile location
- All costs incurred for all material tests as specified on Items 1.6 and 1.7: Source of Supply Testing, Quality Control Testing, and Sieve Analysis Data Sheets for each pit will be required from the successful Contractor.

NOTE: Ward 2 East R.M. Valley Pit price per yard should include the stripping work on the area specified on map attached.

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1.6 Materials – Source of Supply for A-Base (Class “A” Gravel Granular Base Course)

The Contractor shall provide the Municipality with at least six (6) days advance notice of:

- Their intention to commence the production of the Class “A” aggregate; and
- The source of all aggregates to be used on the project including supplementary granular material, three (3) testing samples will need to be collected.

At the request of the Contractor, the Municipality will attend the sample collecting of the binder aggregate obtained from the source of supply. Each sample shall contain no less than 10 kg. The Contractor shall assume all costs incurred in obtaining, transporting, and testing the samples at an Approved Testing Laboratory.

Test results for gradation and physical properties including plasticity and proctor tests will be required but will not constitute acceptance of material in the source of supply.

1.7 Quality Control

All costs incurred for Quality Control Testing shall be the responsibility of the Contractor. The Contractor shall use a qualified testing laboratory to evaluate the aggregate materials being produced meet all specifications in Item 2.1 and 2.2 of this RFP.

The frequencies of Quality Control Testing are as follows:

- One (1) on the first 1,000 cu. yards produced
- One (1) per 5,000 cu. yards on the remaining yards produced

The Contractor shall provide the Municipality with a 48-hour notice prior to the scheduled sample collecting. A Municipal representative is required to be present at that time.

Copies of all Quality Control Testing shall be submitted to the Municipality within two (2) working day of the completion of each test.

Random Testing

Gravel supply may be subject to random testing by the Municipality and at the Municipality's expense.



Project Completion

The Contractor will give the Municipality a 48-hour notice prior to completion of the work. The Municipality will send a representative to do a site inspection at that time.

1.8 Stockpile Base

The Contractor is responsible for the preparation and cleaning of base site for stockpile. R.M. representative will have to inspect base site prior to stockpiling gravel. The Contractor will give the Municipality a 48-hour notice prior to inspection.

1.9 Terms

Evaluation criteria based on:

- Best overall cost effectiveness
- Future associated cost to R.M.
- Stock pile location
- Contractor confidence

For Ward 1 and Ward 2 West gravel crushing, the Municipality requires as part of the RFP, an agreement to stockpile materials for a period of 24 months in the event of inclement weather and the inability to haul the material in 2023, as planned.

- 17,000 Cubic Yards – Townships 10, 11 & 12, Range 23 to 25 – (Ward 1)
- 10,000 Cubic Yards – Townships 10, 11 & 12, Range 28 & 29 – (Ward 2 West)
- 20,000 Cubic Yards – SW Section 36, Township 12, Range 26 – (Ward 2 East) – R.M. Valley Pit

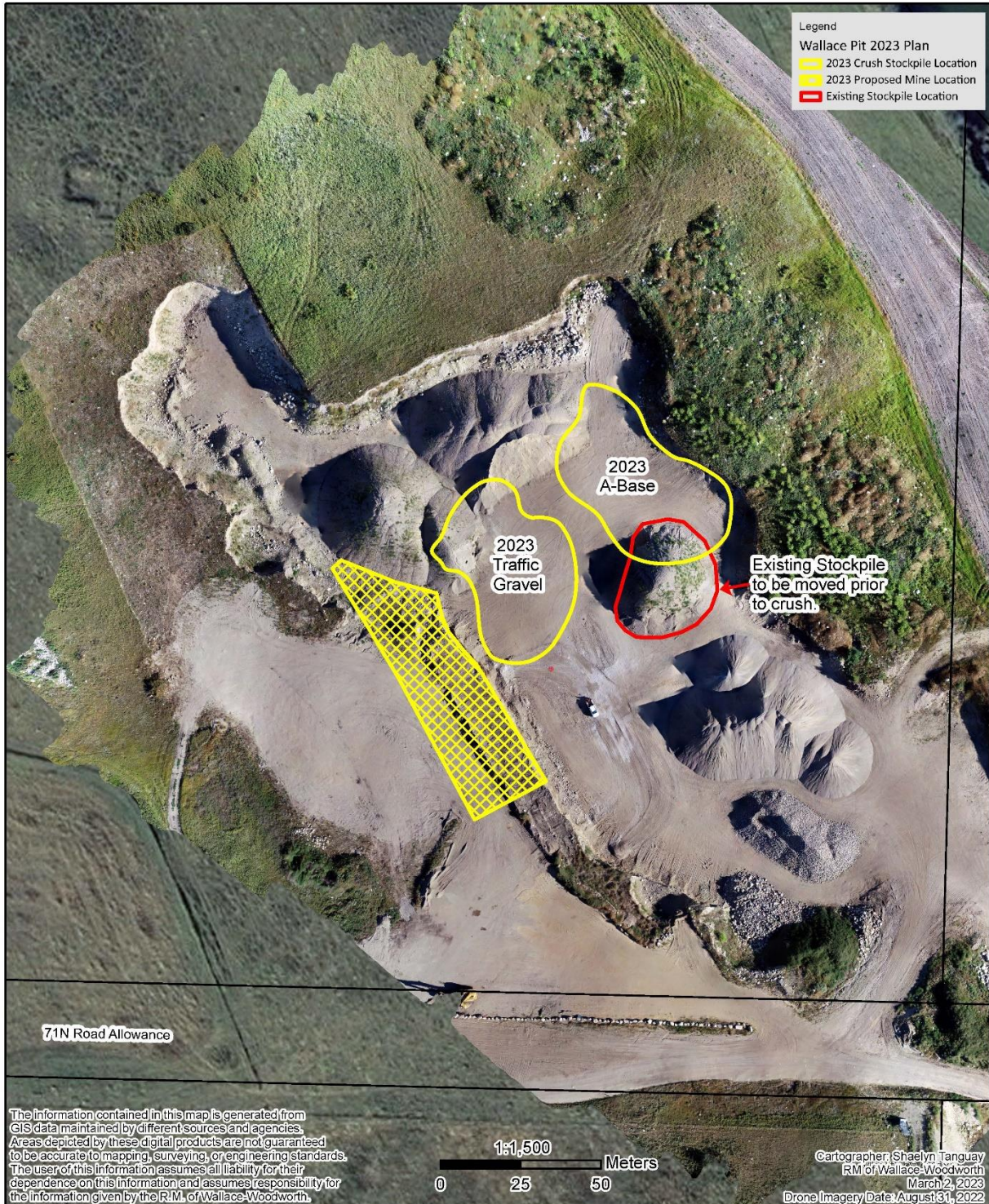
