



## REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

### Kenton LUD 2021 Sidewalk Construction

South side of Woodworth Avenue from Fusion Credit Union, West to Earl Street  
(as per attached map)

#### The work will consist of the following:

- Construction of new sidewalk with an approximate area of 160' x 5'
- Removal of existing sidewalk and excavate surplus material
- Removed material to be disposed of at the Kenton WDG, 2 miles south of Kenton.
- Perform required shaping and compaction of sub-grade.
- Supply and place 3" of crushed base gravel.
- Supply and place 4" of concrete for sidewalk.
- Concrete to be 5000 PSI.
- Concrete to have an entrained air content of between 4.5 and 7%.
- Concrete to have a broom finish with expansion cuts.
- New sidewalk level to tie into existing roadway and/or adjacent sidewalk.
- Contractor responsible to complete all line locates – MTS / MB HYDRO & GAS.
- Contractor to peel back sods in work area and replace if possible or landscape with topsoil and reseed with grass as required.
- Work to be done this Summer, preferably before September 15, 2021.
